NOTES

- 1. DRILL LOCATION** - Drill will be held on the 2nd deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Williw Grove, PA 19044.
- 2. ATTENDANCE** – NSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC.
- 3. COURSEWORK** – All Cadets are required to complete coursework assignments (Airman, Seaman or Basic Military Requirements). A reminder to those Cadets who have not completed Recruit Training: your advancement to E-2 will be in jeopardy if you do not complete coursework. **COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!**
- 4. INCREASE YOUR KNOWLEDGE** – Find out everything you wanted to know about the U. S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps on the NSCC Online Portal: seacadets.org
- 5. PARENTS CORNER** – We are looking for parents to sign up as volunteers with the program. If you are interested in sharing your time and talent, please speak with one of our officers. Parent involvement is very important, and we are looking for adult leadership to lend a helping hand. Please visit our online portal for more information on how to become an adult volunteer.
- 6. CADETS REMINDER** – I know that some of you are very excited and enthusiastic about attending trainings to increase your knowledge and experience. However, all requests for trainings must be submitted as soon as possible to give our staff ample time to respond and prepare you for training.
- 7. CHOW** – On another note, we have been approved to eat in the chow hall on base every drill weekend. The normal cost to eat in the chow hall is \$7.00. I recommend taking advantage of this excellent opportunity to have lunch, which includes a main course, salad, desserts, and drinks. However, bringing your own lunch is also an option.
- 8. PHYSICAL READINESS TEST (PRT)** – The PRT will be conducted at Saturday Drill. All cadets are required to pass the PRT in order to attend trainings and advance in rank.
