## NOTES

1. **DRILL LOCATION** - Drill will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> deck of Building 235, Fairchild Street, Willow Grove, PA 19044.
2. **ATTENDANCE** – NSCC Regulations have changed regarding attendance. They now state that you must attend **50% of all scheduled drills**. That is three of six drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to not meet minimum attendance standards, you may be administratively discharged from the NSCC.
3. **ATTENDANCE** – If parents have concern about cadet safety due to current global tensions and choose not to have their cadet attend drill, please send an email to CO or LPO stating that your cadet will not attend drill. Cadets with a written excuse will receive credit for drill. Use this opportunity to complete coursework.
4. **COURSEWORK** – All Cadets must complete coursework assignments for **each promotion** within **6 months for Sea Cadets** and within **4 months for League Cadets**. **COURSEWORK IS MANDATORY!**
5. **UNIFORM OF THE DAY** – Per the latest Sea Cadets National Headquarters recent guidance on uniforms, cadets shall report in clean, neat civilian attire and change into NWUs on base. Bring PT gear. Cadets must change back into civilian attire before leaving base.
6. **SUPPLY TIME** – Cadets shall review their dress whites and be prepared with requests to replace missing/damaged or poorly fitting uniform pieces. Females, please check your jumper and verify it is marked as a female jumper (check the inside tag/label).
7. **PINNING/PROMOTION CEREMONY** – Cadets participating in Color Guard shall be prepared to present colors, in dress blues, as part of the Pinning/Promotion Ceremony on Sunday.
8. **CHOW** – We have been approved to eat in the chow hall on base every drill weekend. The normal cost to eat in the chow hall is \$8.00. I recommend taking advantage of this excellent opportunity to have lunch, which includes a main course, salad, desserts, and drinks. However, bringing your own lunch is also optional.
9. **HYDRATION** – Canteens are the only acceptable water carriers during trainings and drills. Please see supply if you need a canteen and web belt issued.
